WORLD WAR 1 REMEMBERED - 100 years on

Lance Corporal Stanley K G Fisher,
20726, 174th Co. m/c gun Corps

(Inf.) formerly K/286 the Buffs (East Kent Regt.)

Born in Holloway, London he later resided in New Zealand but by 1911 he was resident in Finsbury Park. Though he enlisted at Folkestone his connection with Lyminge is unknown but his death on 26 September 1917 is included on the War Memorial.

Gunner Thomas G Boughton,
14755 D Battery 95th Brigade, Royal Field Artillery

He was born at 1 Wesley Terrace, Lyminge, the son of John and Sarah Boughton and was 17 when he enlisted at Dover. He was awarded the Military Medal for 'bravery in the field'. He was wounded and admitted to a field hospital but later recovered to re-join his unit where he received further injuries and died at the 133rd Field Ambulance on 27 September 1917.
